Demonstration Topics

These are the topics I can cover in my demonstrations and hands/on courses. I can tailor the list to suit your interests and time frame.

1) Open Bowl turning. I'll rough out a wet wood bowl & then finish a dry one. I put an emphasis on "balancing the grain" –showing how to get the best pattern from a piece of straight grain wood. I'll cover chucking methods, tool use and sharpening & discuss the drying process.

This demo includes:

A- Shaping and sharpening gouges and shear scrapers for bowl turning. I'll demo different grinds for different purposes.

- B- Chucking methods for green and dry wood
- C- Orienting the grain for the best pattern
- D Drying roughed out bowls

2) Sgraffito platter – I'll turn a platter with a wide rim, which is then painted and carved to create a pattern. I'll cover turning beads and coves on faceplate work as well as developing and carving a pattern.





3) Square and textured platter. I'll demo turning a small square bowl & show how I create some of the carved patterns I've developed.

4) Textured and painted platter/bowl – I'll demonstrate turning a bowl with a texture right from the tool and then techniques for using different colors of milk paint to create bowls that look like ceramic or metal pieces.





5) Fluting and carving to add texture to bowls – I'll demonstrate turning a bowl and showing how to flute it using abrasives. I'll also show a few other variations of turned and carved bowls.



6) Digital slide show -I can show a 40 minute slide show of my work and the inspirations behind it.

7) Digital slide show of contemporary turning – A slide show of other turners' work that I admire.
